In 2024, 13 Year 12 completers from The BUSY School (Brisbane) were engaged in education, training or employment in the year after they completed school.



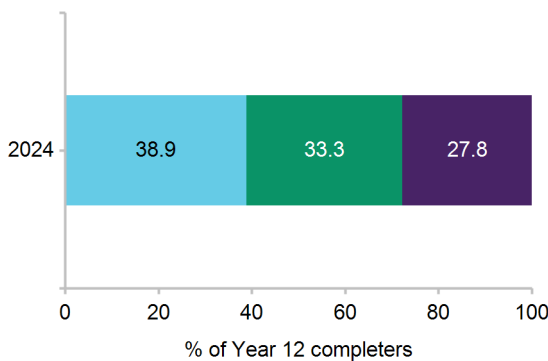
Of the 18 respondents, seven continued in education and training. The most common study destination was VET certificate.



A further six respondents transitioned directly into paid employment only.

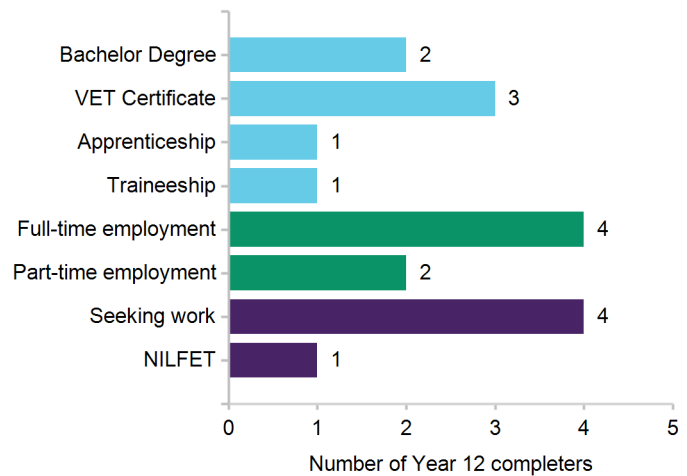
All Year 12 completers were assigned to a *main destination*. Respondents who were both studying and working are reported as being in education or training, including apprentices and trainees.

In 2024, 64.5% of Year 12 completers from The BUSY School (Cairns) were engaged in education, training or employment in the year after they completed school.



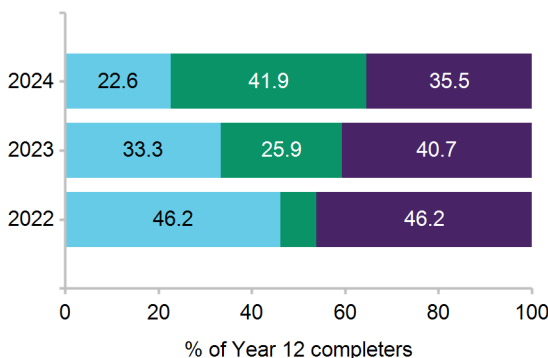
Of the 31 respondents, 22.6% continued in education and training. The most common study destinations were VET certificate and apprenticeship.



A further 41.9% transitioned directly into paid employment only.

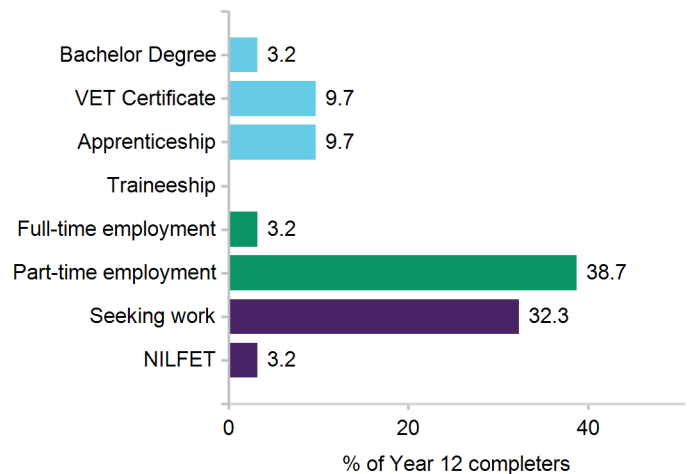

In 2024, 73.9% of Year 12 completers from The BUSY School (Salisbury) were engaged in education, training or employment in the year after they completed school.



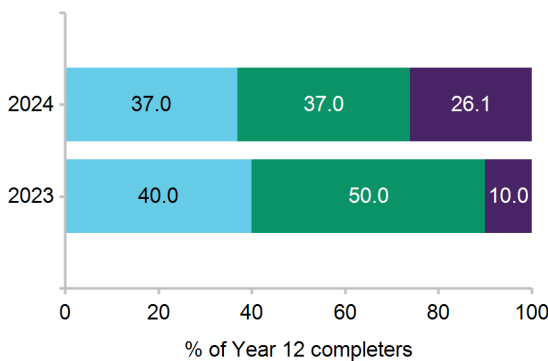
Of the 46 respondents, 37.0% continued in education and training. The most common study destination was apprenticeship.



A further 37.0% transitioned directly into paid employment only.

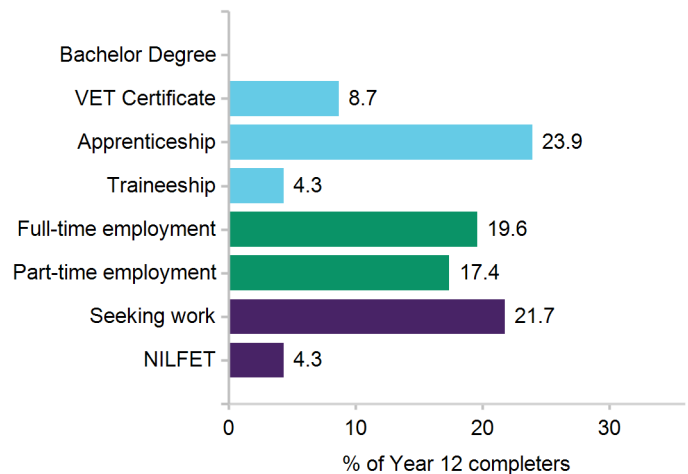

In 2024, 67.4% of Year 12 completers from The BUSY school (Shailer Park) were engaged in education, training or employment in the year after they completed school.



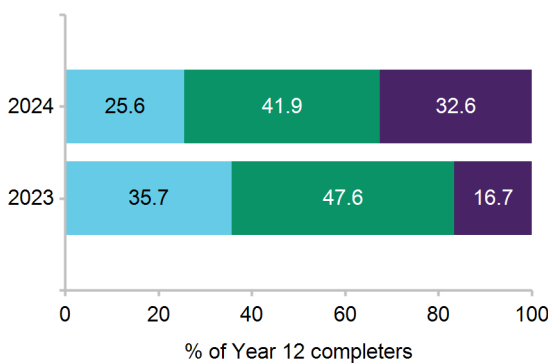
Of the 43 respondents, 25.6% continued in education and training. The most common study destination was apprenticeship.
